### Morning

Starting point: Woburn (Bedfordshire). Home of the Dukes of Bedford - magnificent Woburn Abbey is set in 3,000 acres of parkland, with nine species of deer roaming free. Purchase the delicious prime venison at Woburn Country Foods in nearby Haynes West End.

### Lunch

From Woburn, take the A4012/A421 to the town of Bedford. It is home of the brewer Wells and Young's Ltd. Enjoy lunch (with a pint of Bombardier English Premium Bitter) in the town at one of the numerous cafes, tearooms and restaurants.

### Afternoon

From Bedford, take the A421 to the roundabout with the A1 - where you turn left. Then take the next left to the village of Chawston - where Edible Ornaments are growers of more than 40 different varieties of chilli peppers. Return to the A1 and head south for 8 miles (13 kilometres) to the roundabout with the A6001. Follow this to Holme Mills - and the mill shop of W Jordan (Cereals) Ltd. End your tour by retracing your steps (along the A1) to the town of Sandy for a Bedfordshire Clanger at Gunns Bakery.
